**ACT 100 (SB 236)**

**Foil**

Existing law provides for the issuance of a driver's license and special designation on a driver's license and special identification card.

New law adds a special designation of "seizure disorder" to driver's license and special identification card.

Existing law authorizes an applicant for a driver's license or special identification card to request a designation.

New law adds "seizure disorder" to the list of designations that may be requested on driver's license or special identification card.

Existing law requires the applicant for a driver's license or renewal of a driver's license to provide a sworn statement from a qualified licensed medical professional verifying the medical condition and prohibits any additional fee for the designation.

New law adds the designation of seizure disorder to the list of those who must provide a sworn statement from a qualified licensed medical professional verifying the medical condition and prohibits any additional fee for the designation.

Existing law authorizes the deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of new and existing law.

Effective August 1, 2024.
