<u>Prior law</u> (R.S. 17:3074.1(C)) provided that by January 1, 2022, and at least once every three years thereafter, the advisory council had to review the workforce priorities of the state and each of its workforce regions and designate qualified programs.

<u>New law</u> provides that the La. Workforce Commission convenes the advisory council annually for program updates. Further provides that, at least once every three years, the advisory council must review the workforce priorities of the state and each of its workforce regions and designate qualified programs.

<u>Prior law</u> (R.S. 17:3074.4(C)) provided that state appropriations for the program could not exceed \$10,500,000 per year for students enrolled in public postsecondary education institutions or proprietary schools.

New law changes the state appropriations amount the program cannot exceed  $\underline{\text{from}}$  \$10,500,000  $\underline{\text{to}}$  \$40,000,000.

<u>New law</u> requires that La. Office of Student Financial Assistance is to define the period of the year to which a student must attend an educational program in order to qualify under the provisions of <u>existing law</u>.

Effective May 21, 2024.
