<u>Prior law</u> required the La. State Board of Private Investigator Examiners (board) to assess the following nonrefundable fees on a private investigator agency:

- (1) Application fee \$50.00.
- (2) Examination fee \$50.00.
- (3) Reexamination fee \$25.00.
- (4) Initial license fee \$250.00.
- (5) Annual Renewal license fee \$250.00.
- (6) Replacement fee for a lost, destroyed, or mutilated license \$25.00.

<u>New law</u> retains certain <u>prior law</u> fees, including the application fee, and license replacement fee, and increases other fees, including the examination fee from \$50 to \$100, the reexamination fee from \$25 to \$50, the initial license fee from \$250 to \$300, and the annual renewal license fee from \$250 to \$300.

<u>Prior law</u> required the board to assess the following nonrefundable fees on a private investigator or apprentice investigator:

- (1) Application fee \$50.00.
- (2) Examination fee \$50.00.
- (3) Reexamination fee \$25.00.
- (4) Initial license fee per investigator or apprentice \$100.00.
- (5) Annual Renewal license fee \$100.00.

<u>New law</u> retains certain <u>prior law</u> fees, including the application fee, and increases other fees, including the examination fee from \$50 to \$100, the reexamination fee from \$25 to \$50, the initial license fee per individual or apprentice from \$100 to \$150, and the annual renewal license fee from \$100 to \$150.

Effective August 1, 2024.
