<u>New law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health (LDH) to notify the district attorney and criminal court, regarding a defendant adjudicated not competent to stand trial or not guilty by reason of insanity and committed to LDH, when:

- (1) The defendant is transferred to another facility.
- (2) The defendant is released from custody or placed on conditional release.

<u>New law</u> further requires the district attorney to notify the victim or victim's family if notification has been requested.

<u>New law</u> requires the LDH to notify the district attorney, victim, and criminal court if the person escapes.

<u>New law</u> requires the LDH to notify the same people within 48 hours if the defendant is recaptured.

Effective August 1, 2024.
