<u>Existing law</u> provides relative to limitation of liability for certain persons who use a handgun in self defense.

<u>New law</u> changes <u>existing law</u> references <u>from</u> "handgun" <u>to</u> "firearm" and otherwise retains <u>existing law</u>.

Existing law provides relative to illegal carrying of weapons and provides exceptions.

New law makes technical changes and otherwise retains existing law.

<u>Existing law</u> provides relative to statewide permits for concealed handguns and restricts permit holders from being under the influence of alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance.

<u>New law</u> changes <u>existing law</u> references <u>from</u> "weapon" <u>to</u> "handgun" and otherwise retains <u>existing law</u>.

Effective July 4, 2024.
