## ACT 559 (HB 413)

Existing law provides for payment of \$250,000 to the surviving spouse, child, or other beneficiary of a fireman who suffers death as a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of the performance of his official duties or arising out of any activity in his capacity as a fireman in the protection of life and property. Specifies the paid and volunteer firemen to whom existing law is applicable.

<u>New law</u> expands the applicability of <u>existing law</u> to include any firefighter employed or under the control of one of the following federal agencies if the firefighter is a La. resident and the injury that resulted in the death occurred in La.:

- (1) Dept. of Defense.
- (2) Dept. of Veterans Affairs.
- (3) Dept. of Agriculture.
- (4) Dept. of the Interior.
- (5) Federal Emergency Management Administration.

New law applies retroactively to Aug. 1, 2023.

Effective August 1, 2024.
