<u>Existing law</u> provides for the crime of nonconsensual disclosure of a private image and provides for elements of the offense, penalties, and definitions.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that one of the elements of nonconsensual disclosure of a private image was when the person intentionally disclosed an image of another person who is 17 years of age or older, who was identifiable from the image or information displayed in connection with the image, and whose intimate parts were exposed in whole or in part.

<u>New law</u> changes this <u>prior law</u> element to encompass <u>either</u> the exposing of intimate parts of or the engaging in a sexual performance by the identifiable person.

 $\underline{\text{Existing law}}$ defines the terms "criminal justice agency", "disclosure", "image", and "intimate parts".

New law provides a definition for "sexual performance".

Effective August 1, 2024.
