<u>Existing law</u> provides for the crime of nonconsensual disclosure of a private image and provides for elements of the offense, penalties, and definitions.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that one of the elements of nonconsensual disclosure of a private image was when the person who disclosed the image obtained it under circumstances in which a reasonable person would know or understand that the image was to remain private.

<u>New law</u> changes this <u>prior law</u> element to include obtaining the image through unauthorized access.

<u>Existing law</u> defines the terms "criminal justice agency", "disclosure", "image", and "intimate parts".

New law provides a definition for "unauthorized access".

Effective August 1, 2024.
