## ACT 195 (HB 134) 2024 Regular Session

New law creates the Landscape and Fishery Equipment and Agricultural Fairness Act.

<u>New law</u> defines "agricultural machinery" as any machine or equipment, including a leaf blower, designed for agricultural use or landscaping that is used in accordance with traditional farm practices and is powered by an engine or a motor.

<u>New law</u> defines "fishery equipment" as any equipment used in fisheries operations and generally accepted fisheries practices pursuant to <u>present law</u> (R.S. 56:640.2). Specifies that this term includes, but is not limited to, fish processing machines and machines used for marine, freshwater, and aquaculture species.

<u>New law</u> defines "fuel used in agricultural machinery" to include motor fuel, petroleum products, blended fuel, diesel fuel, and gasoline.

<u>New law</u> prohibits regulations by any local governmental subdivision regarding the use, disposition, or sale or any imposition of a restriction, fee, or tax on fuel used in agricultural machinery and fishery equipment.

<u>New law</u> prohibits any ordinance or regulation by a local government that creates differing standards for fuel used in agricultural machinery and fishery equipment from other fuel or agricultural and fishery equipment.

<u>New law</u> exempts the use of agricultural machinery and fishery equipment owned by a parish or municipality.

Effective August 1, 2024.
