<u>Prior law</u> provided that the Dept. of Revenue and all statutory entities made part of it by law shall begin to terminate their operations on July 1, 2024. <u>Prior law</u> provided that all legislative authority for such entities shall cease as of July 1, 2025, unless, prior thereto, the legislature enacts a bill re-creating the department and its statutory entities.

<u>New law</u> provides for the general re-creation of the Dept. of Revenue and its statutory entities, effective June 30, 2024, within a body of <u>existing law</u> known as the "sunset law". <u>New law</u> supersedes provisions of the sunset law which set out a procedure for review and re-creation of statutory entities and which require a separate bill to re-create each statutory entity within the department along with additional provisions. <u>New law</u> makes July 1, 2029, the new termination date for the department and provides that termination will begin on July 1, 2028, unless the department is re-created again.

Effective June 30, 2024.
