Existing law, applicable to municipalities rather than villages, requires that an elected police chief be an elector of the municipality and requires a candidate for police chief to have been domiciled in the municipality for the year preceding qualifying for the office.

<u>Existing law</u> requires an elected chief of police of a village to reside within the boundaries of the parish in which the village is located.

<u>New law</u> provides an exception for the village of Pine Prairie. Requires that the chief of police reside within the corporate boundaries of the village and requires a candidate to have been domiciled in the village for the year preceding qualifying.

Effective August 1, 2024.
