<u>New law</u> provides that a requirement for additional student instruction shall become effective only if the requirement is offset by the elimination of another instructional requirement, completion of which requires at least the same amount of time as the additional requirement.

New law requires the state Dept. of Education (DOE) to maintain a list of student instruction required by law and not provided for in the state content standards adopted by the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) or the Carnegie units established by DOE in accordance with BESE policy. Specifies list content and requires a report to the House and Senate education committees every five years.

Effective August 1, 2024.
