<u>Prior law</u> required clerks of district courts to collect and disburse a fee and submit information required by the supreme court when a suit had been filed in district court for damages arising from an offense or quasi offense.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that information received by the judicial administrator pursuant to <u>prior law</u> was not subject to subpoena.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 8, 2024).
