<u>Prior law</u> prohibited smoking cigarettes, pipes, cigars, or any vaping devices in a motor vehicle, passenger van, or pick-up truck by a driver or passenger when any child who is required to be restrained in a rear-facing child safety seat, a forward-facing child safety seat, a booster seat, or a motor vehicle's safety belt, as required in R.S. 32:295, was present.

New law changes the prohibition in <u>prior law from</u> any child who is required to be restrained in a rear-facing child safety seat, a forward-facing child safety seat, a booster seat, or a motor vehicle's safety belt, as required in R.S. 32:295, <u>to</u> any child under the age of 13.

Effective August 1, 2024.
