Existing law provides that each sheriff is a member of the Sheriff's Pension and Relief Fund. Provides that each deputy sheriff becomes a member if he is at least 18 years old and meets a minimum monthly salary threshold. Provides that state supplemental pay is included in the determination of a deputy's salary.

<u>Existing law</u> provides various minimum monthly salary thresholds which are applicable based on the date the person was employed. Provides that the threshold is \$1,000 for those employed subsequent to Dec. 31, 2012.

New law provides that the threshold is \$1,250 for those employed subsequent to June 30, 2024.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 24, 2024).
