Existing law authorizes a registrar of voters, upon approval of the secretary of state, to utilize commissioners selected and trained by the registrar of voters to assist the registrar during the early voting period in the conduct of early voting by his office and provides for the qualifications for early voting commissioners.

Existing law prohibits a person who is required to register as a sex offender or child predator from serving as a commissioner-in-charge, commissioner, alternate commissioner, or watcher.

New law also prohibits a person who is required to register as a sex offender or child predator from serving as an early voting commissioner.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 10, 2024).
