Existing law requires health coverage plans to cover a routine colorectal cancer screening.

Prior law defined "routine colorectal cancer screening" as a fecal occult blood test, flexible sigmoidoscopy, or colonoscopy recommended by the American College of Gastroenterology, in consultation with the American Cancer Society.

New law deletes prior law and redefines "routine colorectal cancer screening" as any test or screening recommended by the American Cancer Society or the Nat'l Comprehensive Cancer Network.

Effective August 1, 2024.
