Existing law requires health coverage plans to cover a routine colorectal cancer screening.

<u>Prior law</u> defined "routine colorectal cancer screening" as a fecal occult blood test, flexible sigmoidoscopy, or colonoscopy recommended by the American College of Gastroenterology, in consultation with the American Cancer Society.

<u>New law</u> deletes <u>prior law</u> and redefines "routine colorectal cancer screening" as any test or screening recommended by the American Cancer Society or the Nat'l Comprehensive Cancer Network.

Effective August 1, 2024.
