<u>New law</u> permits a municipal or parochial government to abate a public health or safety risk of an abandoned cemetery when the cemetery is located within the jurisdiction of that municipal or parochial government.

<u>New law</u> provides that the abatement of such risk shall take place at the sole and complete discretion of the governing body upon a majority vote.

<u>New law</u> provides that <u>new law</u> shall not be interpreted to authorize the disturbance of any graves or the moving or removal of human remains or grave markers.

<u>New law</u> requires a municipal or parochial government or a volunteer who is undertaking the abatement to notify the appropriate state authorities in accordance with <u>existing law</u> when exposed human remains are found during abatement activities.

<u>New law</u> permits the parish president or the chief elected official of a municipality to abate any public safety risk or public health hazard in a public or private cemetery caused by the declared disaster in accordance with <u>existing law</u>.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 3, 2024).
