Prior law prohibited barber colleges from admitting students under 17 years of age.

<u>New law</u> changes the age limit for barber college admission <u>from</u> 17 to 16 years of age unless the student is enrolled in a board-approved barber college that operates within a state high school.

Existing law requires the board to examine and determine if an applicant, other than a barber who is covered by reciprocity pursuant to <u>existing law</u>, qualifies for a certificate of registration to practice barbering in the state.

<u>Prior law</u> required the applicant to be at least 18 years old to qualify for a certificate of registration to practice barbering in the state.

<u>New law</u> changes the age requirement for certification from 18 years old to 17 years old.

Effective August 1, 2024.
