<u>Existing law</u> defines commercial body art facilities as facilities that provide tattooing, body piercing, and permanent make-up.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health, through the state health officer, to promulgate rules and regulations to protect public health and govern commercial body art facilities.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the state health officer to promulgate rules that require a minimum standard for sanitary practices, information tracking, public disclosure of the permanence of body art, and post-procedure care.

<u>New law</u> requires commercial body art facilities to disclose on their written consent form the status of state and federal regulation of tattoo ink.

<u>New law</u> requires the state health officer to promulgate rules that require commercial body art facilities to disclose the health risks associated with body art.

Effective August 1, 2024.
