AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 9:2793.13, relative to gratuitous donation of medical equipment or supplies; 3 to provide for a limitation of liability; to provide for an exception; and to provide for 4 related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 9:2793.13 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §2793.13. Gratuitous donation of medical equipment or supplies; limitation of 8 liability 9 Any nonprofit organization that gratuitously donates medical equipment or 10 supplies shall not be liable to any person for any injury, death, loss, civil penalty, or 11 damage as a result of any donated medical equipment or supplies, unless the damage 12 or injury was caused by gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct of the 13 nonprofit organization.

**Abstract:** Provides a limitation of liability for nonprofit organizations that donate medical equipment or supplies.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any nonprofit organization shall not be liable to any person for any injury, death, loss, civil penalty, or damages as a result of donated medical equipment or supplies.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a nonprofit organization may be liable to a person for injury, death, loss, civil penalty, or damages as a result of donated medical equipment or supplies if the damages or injury were caused by gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct of the nonprofit organization.
