**Abstract:** Requires Acadia Parish to elect a parish administrator and provides for terms.

<u>Present law</u> generally requires police juries to elect a parish treasurer for a term of two years. Provides that the office of the parish treasurer shall be located at a site designated by the local governing authority. Requires the parish treasurer to also maintain an office at the parish seat.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> requires the governing authority of Acadia Parish to elect a parish secretary-treasurer for a term of four years. Provides that the term is concurrent with the term of the members of the parish governing authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes <u>present law</u> and instead requires the governing authority of Acadia Parish to elect a parish administrator for a term of four years. Provides that the term shall begin two years after the beginning date of the term of the members of the parish governing authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the term of the secretary-treasurer in office on the effective date <u>proposed law</u> terminates two years after the beginning date of his term. Provides that the term of the parish administrator begins on the termination date of the term of the secretary-treasurer. Additionally provides that the parish administrator's term terminates two years after the beginning date of the next term for the members of the parish governing authority.
