HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of LA 466 in the city of Gretna as "Chief B.H. Miller, Jr. Memorial Parkway"

AN ACT

To designate a portion of Louisiana Highway 466 in the city of Gretna, between Franklin Street and Huey P. Long Avenue, as the "Chief B. H. Miller, Jr. Memorial Parkway"; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. The portion of Louisiana Highway 466 in the city of Gretna, between Franklin Street and Huey P. Long Avenue, shall be known and is hereby designated as the "Chief B. H. Miller, Jr. Memorial Parkway".

Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Designates the portion of LA 466 in the city of Gretna, between Franklin Street and Huey P. Long Avenue as the "Chief B. H. Miller, Jr. Memorial Parkway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the highway designation provided local or private monies are

received by DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.
