1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend The Energy Council on the occasion of its fiftieth anniversary.

3 WHEREAS, The Energy Council is a non-partisan legislative organization founded
4 in 1975 as the Southwest Regional Energy Council and included five original member states:
5 Louisiana, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas, and New Mexico; the organization has grown to
6 fourteen member states with the addition of West Virginia, Mississippi, Alabama, Kansas,
7 Montana, North Dakota, Utah, Wyoming, and Alaska; the Council also welcomed the
8 Canadian provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan; and

9 WHEREAS, The Energy Council was formed to provide a forum for state legislators
10 interested in energy policy, and it allows legislative policymakers to maintain a dialogue and
11 educate themselves about important issues related to the energy sector; and

12 WHEREAS, The Energy Council Executive Committee includes legislators from
13 several member states and the two Canadian provinces; Louisiana is represented on the
14 committee by Senate President J. Cameron Henry, Jr., Senator Kirk Talbot, Representative
15 Ryan Bourriague, and Representative Christopher Turner; and

16 WHEREAS, The Energy Council is an immensely valuable resource for both
17 legislators and their constituencies, especially those in energy-producing states such as
18 Louisiana, and provides a means to acquire a better understanding of energy markets,
19 technology, and policy; and

1 WHEREAS, The Energy Council is most deserving of the highest recognition for
2 leading discussions around responsible energy policy and for serving as a beacon of
3 leadership to legislators across the country.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
5 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend The Energy Council on the occasion of its
6 fiftieth anniversary and does hereby extend enduring appreciation for its efforts to promote
7 responsible energy policy in the state of Louisiana and across the United States.
