10	WHEREAS, Dominican swimmers claimed a number of individual state titles during
11	the LHSAA 2024 State Swim Meet Finals; Terese Vocke won the 500-yard freestyle,
12	Kendall Jollands claimed the titles in the 100-yard butterfly and the 100-yard backstroke,
13	and Haley Valdine won the 200-yard individual medley; and
14	WHEREAS, the team won two relay state titles; Annalise Gagliano, Haley Valdine,
15	Kayleigh Jollands, and Kendall Jollands won the 200-yard medley relay, and Virginia
16	Robinson, Terese Vocke, Kendall Jollands, and Annalise Gagliano won the 400-yard
17	freestyle relay; and
18	WHEREAS, Dominican swimmers claimed several individual honors following the
19	state swim meet; Sydney Ranson won the Lou Reilly Award, which is presented to athletes
20	who continually improve their skills and listen to their teammates and coaches; Haley
