A RESOLUTION

2	To designate Tuesday, April 22, 2025, as Black Farmers and Growers Day at the state
3	capitol and commends black farmers and growers of Louisiana for their outstanding
4	efforts in fostering a more inclusive and sustainable agricultural sector in the state.
5	WHEREAS, the National Black Growers Council (NBGC) is a coalition of
6	multigenerational producers dedicated to advancing the interests of black farmers at the
7	local, state, and national levels; and
8	WHEREAS, the NBGC is a champion in agriculture both within the United States
9	and internationally with a mission to improve efficiency, productivity, and sustainability of
10	black row crop farmers; and
11	WHEREAS, black farmers play a vital role in Louisiana's agricultural landscape,
12	contributing significantly to the state's economy and cultural heritage; and
13	WHEREAS, according to a 2022 Census of Agriculture by the United States
14	Department of Agriculture, Louisiana has roughly three thousand black or African American
15	producers managing over two hundred twenty-six thousand acres of farmland; and
16	WHEREAS, these producers are involved in a diverse range of agricultural activities,
17	including the cultivation of crops such as sugarcane, soybeans, and corn, as well as livestock
18	farming that support local economies and preserve farming traditions passed down through
19	generations; and
20	WHEREAS, despite their contributions, black farmers in Louisiana face challenges
21	such as limited access to capital, land, and technical assistance; and

WHEREAS, organizations like the NBGC work to address these issues by advocating for equitable policies, providing resources, and promoting sustainable farming practices.
