2	To designate Thursday, May 8, 2025, as 4-H Day at the state capitol and to commend the
3	state 4-H officers.
4	WHEREAS, 4-H is the largest youth development organization, empowering
5	approximately six million young people throughout the United States of America; and
6	WHEREAS, through America's land-grant universities, 4-H reaches every corner of
7	the United States, from urban neighborhoods to suburban schoolyards to rural farming
8	communities; and
9	WHEREAS, 4-H represents head, heart, hands, and health as core values of all
10	members, ages eight to eighteen, and works to develop each through engaging programs; and
11	WHEREAS, the Louisiana office of 4-H is the premier youth development program
12	of the Louisiana State University AgCenter Cooperative Extension Service and includes
13	clubs, camps, and after-school programs that help members become responsible citizens
14	leading healthy and productive lives; and
15	WHEREAS, with a network of more than five hundred thousand volunteers, more
16	than three thousand professionals, and nearly six million members, 4-H helps to shape our
17	country's youth in ways that no other youth organization does; and
18	WHEREAS, 4-H empowers all members to reach their full potential, working and
19	learning in partnership with caring adults and growing together as catalysts for positive
20	change; and

1	WHEREAS, 4-H boys and girls are four times more likely to contribute to their
2	communities, including economic achievement and civic engagement; and
3	WHEREAS, the 4-H program is enhanced by leading corporations, foundations, and
4	organizations whose support allows the development of cutting edge models for young
5	people to learn real-world skills that better prepare them for the challenges of today and
6	tomorrow; and
7	WHEREAS, the national 4-H social networks and social media communities are
8	managed by the National 4-H Council and help to further first-of-its-kind research projects
9	to reveal how young people benefit from life-changing experiences; and
10	WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana also
11	recognizes and commends the 2024-2025 state 4-H officers as follows: Breleigh Page,
12	president; Eliza Foster, vice president; Elizabeth Page, secretary; Mattelyn Miller,
13	historian/reporter; and Andrew Chevallier, parliamentarian; and
14	WHEREAS, each officer works with the entire membership to improve their heads
15	for managing clearer thinking, their hearts for caring and greater loyalty, their hands for
16	giving and enlarging service, and their health for better living, all done for their club, their
17	community, their country, and their world.
