The ex officio 7 members shall be the mayor-president, or an officer or employee of the city or parish 8 designated by the mayor-president from time to time; a member of the school board 9 of East Baton Rouge Parish, designated by the school board for a term coincident 10 with his term on the school board; and a member of the planning commission 11 designated by the planning commission for a term coincident with his term on the planning commission. mayors of the following municipalities: Baker, Baton Rouge, 12 13 Central, St. George, and Zachary. Each mayor may designate a person to serve in 14 his place as a member of the commission. Each designee shall serve at the pleasure 15 of the designating mayor. The ex officio members shall serve during their terms of office. The six four appointed members shall be qualified voters of the parish 16 17 appointed by the metropolitan council governing authority of the city of Baton 18 Rouge, parish of East Baton Rouge for terms of three years. Vacancies shall be 19 filled by the designating or appointing body for the unexpired portion of the term 20 authority."
