Abstract: Provides that when a person is convicted of a felony, the criminal justice agency required to submit criminal justice data shall do so electronically through the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System (ICJIS).

<u>Present law</u> requires a sheriff to prepare a statement showing how long a defendant has spent in custody prior to a conviction.

<u>Present law</u> requires the clerk of court to prepare a copy of the indictment and a copy of the Uniform Sentencing Commitment Order and send them to the sheriff of the parish where the defendant is sentenced.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the law enforcement agency that had custody of the defendant to submit the documents required by <u>present law</u> (C.Cr.P. Art. 892) electronically using ICJIS.
