A RESOLUTION

To commend the Baton Rouge Community College men's basketball team for its historic season and for winning its second-consecutive Louisiana Community Colleges Athletic Conference Championship.

WHEREAS, the Baton Rouge Community College (BRCC) Bears men's basketball team finished the season with a school-record twenty wins and only eight losses; the team also enjoyed a fourteen-game winning streak, the longest winning streak in program history, and a dominant 13-2 record at home; and

WHEREAS, the Bears finished with an undefeated, 6-0, record in conference play, securing the Louisiana Community Colleges Athletic Conference (LCCAC) Championship for the second-consecutive season; the team also advanced to the second round of the Region 23 Tournament for the second year in a row; and

WHEREAS, BRCC Head Coach Byron Starks was recognized as the LCCAC Coach of the Year and LABC Coach of the Year for continuing to elevate the Bears each season; and

WHEREAS, BRCC's Kialen Philips was recognized as the LCCAC Player of the Year, and he earned a spot on the All-Region First Team; several other members of the team also received LCCAC honors, showcasing the depth and talent on the roster; and

WHEREAS, the BRCC Bears men's basketball team is most deserving of the highest recognition for its incredible achievements this season and for continuing to elevate the program each year.
