A RESOLUTION

To designate Wednesday, April 30, 2025, as Delta Sigma Theta Incorporated Day at the
state capitol.
WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority was founded on January 13, 1913, by
twenty-two collegiate women at Howard University who were eager to use their collective
strength to promote academic excellence, to provide scholarships and support to those in
need, to educate and stimulate participation in the establishment of positive public policy,
and to highlight issues and find solutions to problems in their communities; and
WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority exercises its collective strength to promote
academic excellence and to provide assistance to the community; and
WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority was incorporated in 1930 and is a private
nonprofit organization that provides assistance and support through established programs
in local communities and throughout the world; and
WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, is the largest African
American Greek letter sorority, a sisterhood of more than three hundred fifty thousand
predominately African American college educated women, comprised of more than one
thousand fifty chartered chapters worldwide; and
WHEREAS, the members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, stand on the
shoulders of giants such as former state representatives Renee Gill Pratt, Rosalind Peychaud,
Jalila Jefferson Bullock, and the late Pinkie Carolyn Wilkerson and former state senators
