2	To commend Dorothy Prevost for her efforts to preserve the legacy of the New Orleans
3	Four.
4	WHEREAS, Dorothy Prevost is the mother of the late Tessie Prevost-Williams and
5	the last-living parent of the New Orleans Four who desegregated public schools in New
6	Orleans, Louisiana, on November 14, 1960; and
7	WHEREAS, Tessie was joined by Gail Etienne, Leona Tate, and Ruby Bridges, and
8	they became the first students to desegregate the public elementary schools in New Orleans,
9	bravely igniting a national movement; and
0	WHEREAS, Mrs. Prevost has worked tirelessly to ensure that history fully
1	acknowledges the sacrifices of all four of these civil rights leaders; in 2020, the New Orleans
12	City Council unanimously supported a resolution establishing November 14 as New Orleans
13	Four Day, and the mayor presented Ms. Etienne, Ms. Tate, and Mrs. Prevost-Williams with
4	keys to the city; and
15	WHEREAS, November 14, 2025, will mark the sixty-fifth anniversary of the New
16	Orleans Four's historic walk, and it is most fitting to recognize Dorothy Prevost for her
17	continued efforts to ensure that all members of the New Orleans Four receive their much
18	deserved recognition for catalyzing a national desegregation movement.
19	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
20	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Dorothy Prevost for her efforts to preserve
21	the legacy of the New Orleans Four and does hereby encourage all Louisianians to join in
