A RESOLUTION

To designate Friday, April 25, 2025, as Arbor Day in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Arbor Day dates back to the 1800s, when journalist J. Sterling Morton proposed the holiday to encourage Nebraska citizens to plant trees; and

WHEREAS, although Arbor Day is not a federal holiday, it was recognized by President Richard Nixon in 1970, and he issued a proclamation commemorating one hundred years of Arbor Day on April 24, 1972; he proclaimed April 28, 1972, as National Arbor Day and encouraged all Americans to celebrate and promote the necessity and value of trees; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is known for its inspiring natural beauty, and the native trees that adorn the state's natural landscape deserve the highest praise and sincerest appreciation.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Friday, April 25, 2025, as Arbor Day in Louisiana and does hereby encourage all Louisianians to support initiatives that promote trees as one of the most valued natural resources in our beautiful state.
