A RESOLUTION

2	To designate Thursday, May 15, 2025, as Tourism Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, travel plays an essential role in preserving Louisiana's culture, propels
4	our economy, and is pivotal in shaping Louisiana's success; and
5	WHEREAS, travel is vital in creating quality job opportunities: 220,500 people are
6	employed in the leisure and hospitality industry in Louisiana, and it is the fourth highest
7	employer in the state; and
8	WHEREAS, Louisiana attracted 43 million domestic and international visitors in
9	2023; those travelers spent an estimated \$18.1 billion while visiting Louisiana, a 5.4%
0	increase over 2022; and
1	WHEREAS, no state general funds are appropriated for tourism, which is funded
12	exclusively by a dedication of three one-hundredths of a cent of sales tax; and
13	WHEREAS, the funds generated by this dedication have been and continue to be
4	used by the Louisiana Office of Tourism under the direction of Lieutenant Governor Billy
15	Nungesser to promote tourism, yielding an enormous positive economic impact to the state;
16	members of the travel community that represent all corners of Louisiana will be at the
17	capitol to represent the industry on Tourism Day.
8	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
9	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Thursday, May 15, 2025, as Tourism Day
