19	A. There is hereby established in the state treasury, as a special fund, the
20	Local Infrastructure Fund, hereafter referred to in this Section as the "fund".
	B. After allocation of money to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund as

23	shall deposit into the fund the following:
	(1) Revenues received from the state sales and use tax collected pursuant to
25	R.S. 47:301.1(F).
26	(2) Monies designated from the fund and received by the state treasurer from
27	donations, gifts, grants, appropriations, or other revenue.
26 27 28 29 30 31 32	C.(1) Monies in the fund shall be appropriated for distribution to ad valorem
29	tax recipient bodies within a parish to offset losses attributable to business inventory
30	exemptions to the ad valorem tax granted by a parish.
31	(2) After appropriation pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, any
32	remaining monies in the fund, not to exceed ten million dollars in a fiscal year, may
33 34	be appropriated for repair, improvement, and consolidation of community water
34	systems and sewer systems for a parish or local governing authority. Priority shall
35	be given to those systems which have not received a grant from the Water Sector

37	(3) Monies in the fund shall be withdrawn exclusively pursuant to a specific
38	appropriation made in a bill enacted by the legislature.
39	D. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the
40	state general fund. Interest earned on investment of monies in the fund shall be
41	credited to the fund. Unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end
42	of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund.

- 8 "Section 5. The provisions of Section 2 of this Act shall take effect and become
- 9 operative if and when the proposed amendment of Article VII of the Constitution of
- 10 Louisiana contained in the Act which originated as House Bill No. 366 of this 2025 Regular
- 11 Session of the Legislature is adopted at a statewide election and becomes effective. The
- 12 provisions of Section 2 of this Act shall supercede in the event of any conflict between
- Section 2 of this Act and Section 1 of this Act."
