WEAPONS/FIREARMS: Authorizes commissioned officers of the Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry to purchase their service weapon upon retirement

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Decreases the active service requirement for a commissioned officer with the Department of Agriculture and Forestry to purchase his service firearm <u>from</u> 20 years <u>to</u> 10 years.
- 2. Makes a technical change.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that any member of the La. State Employees' Retirement System who is a commissioned officer employed by the Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry pursuant to <u>present law</u> (R.S. 3:734 or 4274.1), who has at least 10 years of active service, and who retires under the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 11:441) be entitled to purchase his service firearm at fair market value, subject to the approval of the commissioner of agriculture and forestry.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
