- 19 "§2602. Policy

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A. The legislature finds and declares that persons in this state who seek a place to live should be able to find such housing whenever it is available. Further, in many localities there may be housing shortages. All persons should therefore be able to compete for available housing on an open, fair, and equitable basis, regardless of race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, national origin, military status or natural, protective, or cultural hairstyle.

§2603. Definitions

As used in this Chapter:

- (10) "Military status" means status as:

(b) A dependent as defined in 50 U.S.C. § 3911(4) except that the 36 37 support provided by the service member to the individual shall have 38 been provided one hundred eighty days immediately preceding an 39 alleged action that if proven true would constitute unlawful 40 discrimination under this Section instead of one hundred eighty days

Chapter 2 50. 3 (10) (11) "Natural, protective, or cultural hairstyle" shall include but 4 is not limited to afros, dreadlocks, twists, locs, braids, cornrow braids, Bantu 5 knots, curls, and hair styled to protect hair texture or for cultural significance. (11) (12) "Person" includes one or more individuals, corporations, 6 7 partnerships, associations, labor organizations, legal representatives, mutual 8 companies, joint stock companies, trusts, unincorporated organizations, 9 trustees, trustees in bankruptcy, receivers, and fiduciaries. 10 (12) (13) "Respondent" means the person or other entity accused in 11 a complaint of a discriminatory housing practice, or, any other person or 12 entity identified in the course of an investigation and notified that they are a 13 respondent who shall be joined in the complaint. (13) (14) "To rent" includes to lease, to sublease, to let, and 14 15 otherwise to grant for a consideration the right to occupy premises owned by 16 the occupant. *" 17 18 19 AMENDMENT NO. 6 20 On page 7, after line 17, insert the following: 21 \$2607. Discrimination in residential real estate related transactions 22 A. It is unlawful for any person or other entity whose business 23 includes engaging in residential real estate related transactions to 24 25
- discriminate against any person in making available such a transaction, or in the terms or conditions of such a transaction, because of race, color, religion, 26 sex, disability, familial status, national origin, military status, or natural, protective, or cultural hairstyle. 28
- 29 C. Nothing in this Chapter prohibits a person engaged in the business 30 of furnishing appraisals of real property to take into consideration factors 31 other than race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, military 32 status or familial status.
- 33 §2608. Discrimination in provision of brokerage services

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34 It is unlawful to deny any person access to or membership or 35 participation in any multiple-listing service, real estate brokers' organization 36 or other service, organization, or facility relating to the business of selling or 37 renting dwellings, or to discriminate against him in the terms or conditions 38 of such access, membership, or participation, on account of race, color, 39 religion, sex, disability, familial status, national origin, military status or 40 natural, protective, or cultural hairstyle."
