HOUSE BILL NO. 33

1 AN ACT

2 To enact Paragraph (A)(12) of Section 1 of Act No. 487 of the 1954 Regular Session of the
3 Legislature, as amended by Act No. 655 of the 1997 Regular Session of the
4 Legislature, Act No. 390 of the 2001 Regular Session of the Legislature, and Act No.
5 295 of the 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature, relative to the city of Alexandria;
6 to provide relative to the civil service system for employees of the city; to exclude
7 certain employees from the classified civil service; and to provide for related matters.

8 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
9 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
10 Louisiana.

11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

12 Section 1. Paragraph (A)(12) of Section 1 of Act No. 487 of the 1954 Regular
13 Session of the Legislature, as amended by Act No. 655 of the 1997 Regular Session of the
14 Legislature, Act No. 390 of the 2001 Regular Session of the Legislature, and Act No. 295
15 of the 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

16 Section 1. (A) It shall be the policy of the city of Alexandria to employ those
17 persons best qualified to perform the functions of the city and to foster effective
18 career service in city employment. Any appointment and promotion of any
19 employee in the classified service of the city and of each of its departments, offices,
20 and agencies shall be made on the basis of merit and fitness which shall be
21 determined, insofar as practicable, by competitive test. All employees of the city of
22 Alexandria, except employees of the fire and police departments shall be in the

1 classified service, except that the following shall not be in the classified service and
2 shall not be subject to the provisions of this Act regarding appointment, promotion,
3 and dismissal:

5 (12) Any employee who provides city computer operations, including but not
6 limited to direct services to the municipal information systems, electronic security
7 systems, and other vulnerability and information technology designed to prevent
8 disruption and compromise of sensitive information.
