A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Southeastern Conference to schedule football games at Louisiana State University after six o'clock in the evening during the month of September for health and safety reasons related to the heat during day games.

WHEREAS, in Louisiana, the heat index is often above one hundred degrees in the month of September; and

WHEREAS, local news outlets reported that there were dozens of heat-related medical incidents in and around Tiger Stadium at a day game in September of 2024; and

WHEREAS, due to the often extreme heat of September in this state and in the interest of protecting the health and safety of players, coaches, staff, and fans, it is appropriate that the Southeastern Conference take measures necessary to schedule September football games in the evening.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Southeastern Conference to schedule football games at Louisiana State University after six o'clock in the evening during the month of September.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the commissioner of the Southeastern Conference.
