COMMENDATIONS: Commends Alexandra Gramby on being named Louisiana's first national Miss Juneteenth

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Alexandra Gramby on being named Louisiana's first national Miss Juneteenth.

3 WHEREAS, Alexandra Gramby is an eighteen-year-old resident of Maurice,
4 Louisiana, and 2025 graduate of North Vermilion High School; she is the daughter of
5 Frankie and Stacie Brooks, and her maternal grandfather, former Lafayette attorney David
6 Dennis, is a prominent civil rights activist who rose to the global stage during the 1960s and
7 served as the Mississippi director of the Congress of Racial Equality; and

8 WHEREAS, Alexandra is the first Louisiana Miss Juneteenth Queen to win the
9 National Miss Juneteenth Queen title, and she has earned national recognition while touring
10 the country as a goodwill ambassador; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Gramby joined the SWLA Committee and associations and groups
12 across the country in the ringing of bells to commemorate the National Freedom Day
13 Observance, and she performed the United States national anthem and a song about the 13th
14 Amendment; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Gramby also joined the regional Juneteenth Committee, the Greater
16 SWLA Black Chamber of Commerce, and others to host an African American history
17 program for youth across the eight-parish region; and

18 WHEREAS, Alexandra Gramby plans to attend the University of Louisiana at
19 Lafayette, where she will study nursing; she is truly deserving of the highest recognition for
20 her incredible achievements, which have brought immense pride to the state.

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
2 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Alexandra Gramby on being named
3 Louisiana's first national Miss Juneteenth and does hereby extend sincerest wishes that she
4 continue her excellent work and prosper in all of her endeavors.
