age groups and dividing by two. If the average number is not a whole number, the
 number shall be rounded down to a whole number.

 youngest child determines the child to staff ratio for the group."

25 (c) A statement notifying parents and legal guardians that the document is being
 26 distributed pursuant to "Charlie's Law".

27 (2) The state Department of Education shall provide the document to each early
 28 learning center and prekindergarten program no later than August first of each year.
 29 (3) Each early learning center and public school with a prekindergarten

30 program shall distribute the document to the parents and legal guardians of all
 31 children enrolled in an early learning center or prekindergarten program.

32 (4) The document shall be distributed at the beginning of each school year and
 33 may be distributed electronically.

34C. The state Department of Education shall provide written notification to the35superintendent of a school district for any complaint received by the department36regarding a prekindergarten program in the district pursuant to this Section."
