WHEREAS, Bill Johnson is survived by his loving wife, Gloria H. Johnson; daughter, Zindy Laursen-Johnson (Denmark); bonus children, Kerry Gosa (Wathlene), Gregory Gosa (Gail), and Karen Breaux; grandchildren and great-grandchildren; sisters, Dorothy Armwood (Weldon) and Daisy Carson (Scottie); niece, Janice Johnson-Dunn; and a host of extended relatives and friends; he will be deeply missed, but the legacy of his love shall live on in perpetuity in the hearts of those who were privileged to have known him.
