**SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL**

1. Changes the term "health insurer" to "health insurance issuer".

**DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE**

SB 138 Engrossed

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Present law allows a district attorney's office to offer group health insurance to its employees.

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law requires a health insurance issuer to provide coverage to a retired employee of a district attorney's office funded by a local dedicated sales and use tax on the same terms as to an active employee of the office when the retiree is not yet eligible for Medicare, if the district attorney's office provides health insurance coverage to its retirees.

Proposed law does not require a district attorney's office to offer health insurance coverage to retirees.

Effective August 1, 2025.
