WHEREAS, Mr. Brown made his mark on Shreveport radio history serving as DJ Yoshi on 103.7 The Beat and co-hosting the radio show, "3 Kings of Radio", with DJ Breeze and Scooter Man Pro; he also served as the co-host DJ on KTAL's "Living Local", which highlights people and events across northwest Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brown founded Red Line Marketing and Branding, and he provides his talent and energy to radio, TV, and live performances; in 2024, he was appointed as the vice president of the Shreveport Chapter of the Louisiana GoDjs Coalition; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brown performs under the name "Hot Boy Yoshi", and he has transformed his passion for music into a vibrant force that uplifts the community and celebrates Shreveport's rich cultural tapestry to a wider audience; he has performed at a
