COMMENDATIONS: Commends the Paris Saint-Germain Football Club on winning its first UEFA Champions League title

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the Paris Saint-Germain Football Club on winning its first UEFA Champions  
3 League title.

4 WHEREAS, the Paris Saint-Germain Football Club lifted the UEFA Champions  
5 League Trophy for the first time in club history after a dominant 5-0 victory over Inter Milan  
6 in the final of the 2024-2025 Champions League on May 31, 2025, at Allianz Arena in  
7 Munich, Germany; and

8 WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain Football Club, known by fans as Les Rouge-et-  
9 Bleu, received the support of eighteen thousand fans in attendance at the game in Munich  
10 and tens of thousands more across France and the rest of the world; and

11 WHEREAS, with the addition of the 2025 UEFA Champions League Trophy, Paris  
12 Saint-Germain has fifty-five domestic and international titles in its trophy cabinet; the club  
13 has won thirty-seven trophies since being acquired by Qatar Sports Investments; it won three  
14 other trophies in 2025: the Trophée des Champions, the Ligue 1 title, and the Coupe de  
15 France; prior to winning the Champions League, the club's only European trophy was the  
16 1996 European Cup; and

17 WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain fielded the second-youngest winners in Champions  
18 League history, with an average age of twenty-four years and three months; the club relied  
19 on its incredible attacking depth, with a record seven players involved in at least five goals  
20 throughout the tournament; and

1           WHEREAS, Paris Saint-Germain Football Club is led by its president, Nasser Al-  
2 Khelaïfi, and the men's team is managed by Luis Enrique; the team's goalkeepers are  
3 Gianluigi Donnarumma, Matvey Safonov, and Arnau Tenas; the defenders are Achraf  
4 Hakimi, Presnel Kimpembe, Marquinhos, Lucas Hernandez, Nuno Mendes, Lucas Beraldo,  
5 Yoram Zague, Naoufel El Hannach, and Willian Pachó; the midfielders are Fabián Ruiz,  
6 Vitinha, Lee Kang-in, Senny Mayulu, Warren Zaïre-Emery, and João Neves; and the  
7 forwards are Khvicha Kvaratskhelia, Gonçalo Ramos, Ousmane Dembélé, Désiré Doué,  
8 Bradley Barcola, and Ibrahim Mbaye; and

9           WHEREAS, New Orleans-based Consul General of the French Republic, the  
10 Honorable Rodolphe Sambou, is a passionate fan of Les Rouge-et-Bleu; the team will look  
11 to add another trophy when it travels to the United States to compete in the FIFA Club  
12 World Cup this June; and

13           WHEREAS, the Paris Saint-Germain Football Club is most deserving of the highest  
14 recognition for winning European soccer's most-prestigious prize: the UEFA Champions  
15 League Trophy.

16           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Paris Saint-Germain Football Club on  
18 winning its first UEFA Champions League title; does hereby offer a warm welcome to the  
19 United States when the team visits for the FIFA Club World Cup; and does hereby extend  
20 sincerest wishes that club continue to prosper in all of its competitive endeavors for many  
21 more years to come.
