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Increases the tanker truck registration fee applicable to certain trucks transporting liquefied petroleum gas

Present law prohibits tanker trucks with a water capacity of 1,000 gallons or more from transporting liquefied petroleum gas unless it is registered with the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission and a \$50 annual registration fee is paid. This bill increases the annual registration fee from the current \$50 to a maximum of \$100 from 8/01/25 through 7/31/30; thereafter the fee may be set up to \$150.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation will increase SGR revenues for the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission by approximately \$90,000 annually from increasing registration fees from \$50 up to a maximum of \$150 for tanker trucks with water capacity of at least 1,000 gallons. OMV reports 1,800 tanker trucks apply for registration annually.

The \$180,000 increase for the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission is calculated as follows:

Proposed law $(1,800 \text{ registrants } \times \$100 \text{ fee} = \$180,000)$ = \$90,000Current law (1,800 registrants x \$50 fee
