SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes June 19, 2025, as a day of celebration in Louisiana in honor of Juneteenth

A RESOLUTION

2	To recognize June 19, 2025, as a day of celebration in Louisiana in honor of Juneteenth.
3	WHEREAS, on January 1, 1863, President Abraham Lincoln issued the
4	Emancipation Proclamation, which declared "that all persons held as slaves" within the
5	Confederacy "are, and henceforth shall be free"; and
6	WHEREAS, news of the end of slavery traveled slowly after President Lincoln
7	issued the Emancipation Proclamation, particularly to southwestern states; and
8	WHEREAS, indeed, the belated news relative to the Emancipation Proclamation did
9	not arrive to the Confederacy until June 19, 1865, months after the conclusion of the Civil
0	War; and
1	WHEREAS, subsequently, June 19th became known as "Juneteenth"; it is an annual
12	observance and celebration of the date Union soldiers enforced the Emancipation
13	Proclamation freeing all remaining slaves in Galveston, Texas, on June 19, 1865; and
4	WHEREAS, Juneteenth commemorates the strength and resolve of
15	African-Americans throughout history, and is an opportunity to highlight the value of
16	African-American culture, art, history, and achievement; and
17	WHEREAS, the celebration of the end of slavery is an important and enriching part
18	of the history and heritage of the United States.
19	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
20	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize June 19, 2025, as a day of celebration in
