Existing law requires a sheriff to prepare a statement showing how long a defendant has spent in custody prior to a conviction.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the clerk of court to prepare a copy of the indictment and a copy of the Uniform Sentencing Commitment Order.

<u>Prior law</u> required the clerk of court to send the documents required by <u>existing law</u> to the sheriff of the parish where the defendant was sentenced.

<u>New law</u> requires the law enforcement agency that had custody of the defendant to submit the documents required by <u>existing law</u> (C.Cr.P. Art. 892) electronically using the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System.

Effective August 1, 2025.
