Existing law requires that clinical laboratory personnel be licensed by the Clinical Laboratory Personnel Committee in order to practice clinical laboratory science in clinical laboratory settings.

Existing law creates an exception to the licensing requirement for clinical laboratory personnel practicing clinical laboratory science in either a clinical laboratory operated by the U.S. government or a nonprofit laboratory operated and maintained exclusively for instruction and research involving no individual patients.

New law adds an exception to the licensing requirement for clinical laboratory personnel practicing clinical laboratory science in a source plasma donation center that only performs nondiagnostic tests for the purpose of screening source plasma donors.

New law defines the term source plasma.

Effective August 1, 2025.
